The lock assigned to your hangar is a very high security variant with keys that are virtually impossible to duplicate. Because of the secure nature of these locks, **duplicate keys will not be provided when a key is lost.** Should you lose a key, all remaining keys for that lock will need to be destroyed and a locksmith will be called out to re-key the lock cylinder and ordered a minimum of four new keys. You, as the tenant of record for this hangar are financially responsible for costs associated with replacement of a lost or damaged lock, key, lock cylinder, re-keying the lock cylinder and replacing keys. The costs associated with each of these actions can be found in the most current *Schedule of Fees and Charges for Santa Clara County*.

You are being assigned a hangar that is equipped with a fire-extinguisher. You, as the tenant of record for this hangar are financially responsible for the cost associated with replacement of a lost or stolen fire-extinguisher. However, the County will inspect, refill, and repair fire extinguishers on an annual basis at its own expense.

Should I lose any one key, I agree to pay for the replacement of all keys assigned to my lock (minimum of 4) and to pay a locksmith charge to have the lock cylinder re-keyed. Should I lose the entire lock, I agree to pay for the replacement of the lock, cylinder and a minimum of four keys. I understand that these costs are spelled out in the most current *Schedule of Fees and Charges for Santa Clara County Airports*.
